If you want to meet the requirements of the fire safety law in your workplace then this course is for you.

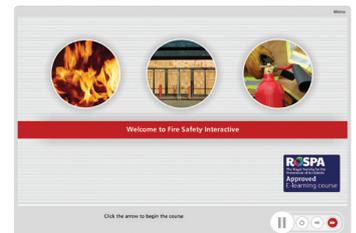
How it works?
