Governing Body

- SANCSC has an executive committee (EC) which is made up of:
 - o President
 - Vice President
 - Secretary
 - o Treasurer

NOTE 1: The EC is voted on every two years in February of the election year (projected for 2026)

NOTE 2: One year of membership is required to be elected to the EC

- The President appoints:
 - o Parliamentarian (Interprets and assures adherence to "Roberts Rules of Order" among other duties)
 - Chaplain (Conducts prayer and invocation at meetings/other functions)
 - o Master-at-Arms/Assistant Master-at-Arms (Assures proper decorum at meetings/gatherings)
 - o Historian (Maintains data on important dates/events, among other duties)

How to Become a Member

• Submit an application to a SANCSC member for acceptance/approval by a voting committee

Membership Meetings

- Monthly meetings are conducted on the last Saturday of each month (in-person or virtually). Locations (in-person) and times are be announced.
 - o All active members are expected to attend meetings

Monthly Dues

- All active members are required to pay monthly dues
 - o \$15.00 monthly/\$180 annually
- Each new member will pay an initial fee of \$150.00 within 30 days of acceptance to cover the following:

 - 2 Caps
 - 1 Apron
 - 2 Lapel pins
 - The first two months of dues (next dues payment in the third month)
