Entrance Screening Guidelines

To prevent the spread of COVID-19 in our facilities and reduce the risk of exposure to our staff and partners we requires a brief health screening in advance of your entrance into the facility.

 Please be aware that you will need to follow all site protocols, which includes having your temperature taken, as a prerequisite for entering any of our facilities. The facility reserves its right to deny anyone displaying potential symptoms and/or not willing to follow facility protocols. Individuals with a temperature over 100 F or 37.8 C, confirmed twice, will not be permitted entry. Those above 100 F or 37.8 C will not be permitted entry after one reading.

SCREENING QUESTIONS	
1	Have you or any member of your immediate family experienced flu-like symptoms (including fever, cough or shortness of breath) in the past 14 days?
2	To your knowledge, have you been in contact with a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 affected individual in the past 14 days?
3	Have you been to any affected area experiencing COVID-19 infections in the past 14 days?
4	Have you been told to quarantine?

By entering the facility, you acknowledge that you have read the above privacy statement, answered "no" to the above questions and consent to the collection and use of your personal information as set forth above.

PRIVACY: Any personal information collected will be appropriately secured and will only be used to inform our COVID-19 response efforts to protect the health and safety of our associates and the general public. Accordingly, please be aware that your personal information, including without limitation, your travel document data, health conditions and travel history, may be shared by us with relevant government authorities as determined necessary and appropriate to support the vital interest of protecting our public health.
