Customer(s)	Member Associations
Service Specifications	<p>The FIFA Connect Platform Service is an online system for the registration of Stakeholders, provided by FIFA to Member Associations.</p> <p>Depending on the Member Associations' regulations, it comprises the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Registration of the Stakeholders of the Member Associations - Addition of roles to existing Stakeholders and changes to Player levels - Registration and de-registration of domestic and international transfers - Registration document management - Online payment of registration fees to the Member Associations by the Stakeholders - Registration approval and document review - Deduplication process - Electronic player passport and registration history - Printing of football ID cards - Reporting and statistics
Defects	In the event of a Defect, once its root cause has been found, fixed, and tested, the fix will be packaged and released into production as well as communicated as stated in the "Queries and Notices" section below.
Use of Data by FIFA	<p>Further to the provisions of section 8 of the Terms of Use, FIFA may use the Data for the following purposes as part of the FIFA Connect Platform Service:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To transfer the Data to the FIFA Connect ID Service for the generation of FIFA IDs for the Stakeholders of the Member Associations and for the identification of potential duplicate registrations of the FIFA ID for the same Stakeholder - To support the payment of training and solidarity contributions - To protect minors - To enable the exchange of Data between the Member Associations as well as between FIFA and the Member Associations - To create and use statistics (including disclosure and transfer to third parties in an aggregated format) for measuring and managing football participation and development

Use of Data by Customer(s)	As part of the FIFA Connect Platform Service, the Member Associations may use the Data for the purpose of registration according to their relevant regulations and those of FIFA.
Termination and Expiration	<p>Either Party may terminate the Contract for the FIFA Connect Platform Service at any time by giving twelve (12) months' prior written notice to the other Party.</p> <p>Either Party may further terminate the Contract for the FIFA Connect Platform Service with immediate effect in writing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - if the other Party commits an irremediable material breach thereof; - if the other Party commits a remediable material breach thereof and fails to remedy the same within 14 days of being requested to do so in writing; - if the other Party enters into or has insolvency, liquidation, or similar proceedings instituted against it. <p>In addition, FIFA may terminate the Contract for the FIFA Connect Platform Service with immediate effect in writing on grounds that FIFA deems serious, such grounds including, without limitation, changes in law, other legal requirements, or FIFA rules or regulations; non-compliance by Customer with FIFA rules or regulations; governmental sanctions against Customer; or reputational issues pertaining to Customer.</p> <p>Furthermore, the Contract for the FIFA Connect Platform Service will automatically and immediately expire at the time that either Customer or FIFA ceases to exist or, if applicable, at the time that Customer ceases to be a member of FIFA.</p>
