The trading of commodities and currencies involves a significant amount of risk. Prices can fluctuate on any given day. Because of such price fluctuations, any Customer may gain or lose value of his/her assets at any given moment. Any currency may be subject to large swings in value and may even become absolutely worthless. There is always an inherent risk that losses will occur as a result of buying, selling or trading anything on the market.

Cryptocurrencies trading has specific risks, which are not shared with other official currencies, goods or commodities in a market.

Unlike most currencies, which are supported by government reserves or other legal entities, as well as commodities such as silver and gold, most cryptocurrencies are a "fiat" currency, which is only backed by mathematics, technology and trust. The currency is absolutely decentralized, which means there is no authority that can take corrective measure to protect its value in a crisis or issue more currency.

Cryptocurrencies are an autonomous and mostly unregulated worldwide payment system. When using cryptocurrencies – traders put their trust in the digital, decentralized and mostly anonymous system, which relies on p2p networking and cryptography to maintain its integrity.

There may be additional risks, which have not been foreseen or identified in the current Terms of Use.

Every User has to carefully assess whether his/her financial situation and tolerance for risk is suitable for buying/selling/trading cryptocurrencies.

As the Company’s Customer, please note that:

- cryptocurrency products are complex and high risk and as such come with a high risk of losing all the invested capital;
- virtual currencies values can widely fluctuate (high volatility) and may result in significant loss over a short period of time;
- virtual currencies are not appropriate for all investors and therefore, investors should not trade in such products if they don’t have the necessary knowledge and expertise in this specific product; they should always be fully aware and understand the specific characteristics and risks related to these products.
