Teacher's instructions:



Watch Someturva's case example video "Alastonkuvat" (<u>link to video</u>, English subtitles, 5,5 minutes)

The video includes discussion questions. You can pause the video during the discussion.

- What are your thoughts on the example?
- How would you feel if your nude photo ended up in the wrong hands?
- What should you do if you see someone's nude photo spreading on social media?
- How could the situation in the case example be resolved?

Please note: the video discusses the criminal offences that apply if the nude photo is of a minor. If someone shares a nude photo of someone over 18 without permission, it can be a crime called "Non-consensual dissemination of a sexual image" (in Finnish "seksuaalisen kuvan luvaton levittäminen").







Teacher's instructions

- 2 In pairs or small groups, create posters raising awareness about online harassment that you can put on the classroom wall.
 - Pairs/groups can be formed functionally by asking students to queue up according to their birthday and dividing them by the queue order.
 - Finally, each group can present their poster.
 - Equipment needed: computer and software for making a poster (e.g. Word or PowerPoint) or A4 paper and coloured pencils.
- Students take turns telling in one sentence what they learned from the lesson.



Teacher's instructions:
