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Programme Units

Food Production Techniques (80 hours)

This unit will provide students with knowledge and practical skills in relation to current food trends influencing the style and content of modern day menus.

Wine and Beverage Studies (20 hours)

This unit provides students with the key product and operational knowledge required to successfully organise and manage the sale of beverages in a commercial environment.

Bakery Products (40 hours)

This unit allows students to cover a range of basic pastry and baking techniques which will provide them with a solid grounding in this specialised discipline.

Food Service (50 hours)

This practical unit focuses on the development of students' service skills and knowledge of the key relationship between front-of-house and kitchen in a restaurant environment.

Professional Production (50 hours)

This intensive unit will involve competence based practical skills in a working kitchen environment. Students are introduced to basic technical skills, styles, equipment and procedures.

Students wishing to enter this programme must satisfy the following requirements:
