### Introduction Marvesa Group

### Job description

We are currently looking for a committed and motivated colleague who enjoys having a diverse job. You will be joining a small operations team, and this comes with taking your own responsibility for your work. In total we are shipping approximately 400.000 MT of oil per year, mainly in oil/chemical tankers. We handle approximately 600 import containers and around 1500 export containers per year globally, in various types of containers (ISO tanks, flexitanks, 20'DV & 40'DV), with intentions to keep growing. This includes transport per container vessels, container barges, trains and trucks, mainly in South America, North America, Asia, Caribbean and Europe. In this role you will be responsible for requesting and negotiating freight quotes and full A to Z operations of our import and export containers for both our feed and energy divisions.

### Your Responsibilities

- Request/negotiate freight quotes with freight forwarders and or shipping companies, tank owners, truck transporters, etc.
- Smooth execution of our purchase and sales contracts from A to Z.
- Monitor open contracts and plan the shipments in time.
- Monitor loading/discharge schedule per terminal to avoid exceeding max daily capacity (avoid/minimize demurrage).
- Settle demurrage/detention claims per shipment and minimize costs.
- Settle container cleaning costs and minimize costs.
- Think proactively about the optimisation of the logistics flow based on your knowledge and contacts.
- Stay in contact with freight forwarders, customers, suppliers, customers, customs agent, transporters, terminals.
- Coordinate deliveries with recipients and coordinate departures (schedules) with the forwarder.
- Check last cargoes of ISO tanks.
- Create loading and unloading orders.
- Clearing in and out of goods through our customs agent.
- Insure the cargo.
- Check documents for correctness/validity for import container shipment.
- Book in/book out goods in our ERP system (Microsoft AX 2012).
- Report status of container shipments to management and logistics department.
- Update the ETA's twice per week for our product planning (for supply & demand meetings).
- Process incoming goods and expense invoices.
- Create commodity/expense invoices.
