



1 FEES

- 1.1 Any player participating in at least one stage must have a valid 3x3 license, which is separate from the 5x5 license. If a player participates without a license, they have 10 days to regularize their situation; otherwise, additional fees may apply, or the team may be disqualified from the Tour.
- 1.2 Each organizer is free to set an entry fee for their tournament. These fees may include jerseys, access to side activities, meals, or any other event-related expenses.

2 TEAM ROSTER

- 2.1 The Tour roster is unlimited. A minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 players can be registered per stage.
- 2.2 All players must have a confirmed FIBA 3x3 Play profile.
- 2.3 Once a player has competed in a stage with a team, they cannot play for another team for the remainder of the Tour.
- 2.4 There is no limitation on the number of foreign players per team.
- 2.5 Each player must sign this Handbook to be allowed to participate in the Tour.

3 TEAM NAME

- 3.1 The team name must correspond to a Swiss city (neighborhoods, regions, or countries are not accepted).
- 3.2 Two teams cannot have the same name first come, first served.
- 3.3 Once a team name has been used in a stage, it cannot be used again by another team.

4 FINAL

- 4.1 The 5 winning teams from each stage are automatically qualified for the final.
- 4.2 If a team that is already qualified wins a stage, the runner-up team will qualify instead.
- 4.3 The remaining spots for the final will be awarded to the highest-ranked teams based on FIBA points.
- 4.4 At least 2 players who contributed to the team's qualification must be on the final roster.
- 4.5 Finalist teams will receive an official Elite Women Tour jersey.
- 4.6 The winning team of the Elite Women Tour Final will receive prize money.

5 SANCTIONS & FINES

- In case of non-compliance with the rules of play, this Handbook, registration conditions, or the competition's ethical code (disrespect, damage to equipment or venue, etc.), Swiss Basketball may invoice the damages and apply a CHF 500 fine. The team may also be disqualified from the Tour.
- 5.2 A qualified team that does not show up for the final without a valid reason may be banned from participating in the next edition of the Tour.



5.3 A team arriving late to the tournament without notifying Swiss Basketball or the organizer at least 30 minutes in advance or without a valid reason will forfeit the missed games.
