

## **Cookie privacy Talos Information**

Dear Customer,

with reference to the measure “Individuation of the simplified way to inform and consent acquiring to use the cookie – 8 may 2014” (published on the Gazzetta Ufficiale n. 126 of 3 June 2014), they are described in a specific and analytic way the characteristics and purposes of the cookie installed on this site indicating also the ways to select/deselect the single cookie.

The WEB site “**www.talos-sec.com**” property of “**Talos s.r.l.s.**”, with legal site in Savona, Via Magliotto, 2, 17100, Web: [www.talos-sec.com](http://www.talos-sec.com) – e-mail: [support@talos-sec.com](mailto:support@talos-sec.com) –, hereon called only “**Site**” – uses the cookies to offer its services to the Users while consulting its pages.

The tables reported here below summarize the different types of cookie that could be used on the Site, together with their respective function and length (how long each cookie will stay on your device).

The information is valid only for the mentioned Site and its related second level domains and not for eventual other sites to be consulted by the link. Using this Site you agree our use of cookie complying the present **Cookie privacy information**.

If you do not agree to our use of cookie, it is necessary to set own browser in a suitable way or not to use the present site or the eventual corresponding second level domains. If you decide to disable the cookie it could be influenced the user experience while browsing in the Site.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE COOKIES**

#### **What are the cookies and what they are for?**

The cookie are computer files or partial data that can be stored in the computer or on other internet enabled devices, for example smartphone or tablet when you visit a Site.

Usually a cookie contains the name of the internet site which the cookie is coming from, the “life” of the cookie (it means how long it will remain on the device), and a value that generally is a unique number generated casually. The present document gives detailed information on the use of the cookie and of similar technologies, about how they are used by the Site and how to manage them.

The cookies generate information to be reused during the same visit to the site (session cookies) or later, also after some days (persistent CDs cookies). The cookies are stored, depending the user's preferences, by the single browser on the specific used device (computer, tablet, smartphone).

Similar technologies, such as, for example, web beacon, transparent GIFs and all the forms of local storage introduced with HTML5, can be used to gather information about the user behaviour and the use of the services.

### **Types of cookies**

Complying the characteristics and the use of the cookies we can distinguish different categories:

- **Absolutely necessary technical cookies.** They are indispensable cookies for the correct use of the Site “www.talos-sec.com” and they are used to manage the login and the access to the reserved functions. The cookies duration is strictly limited to the working session, in fact once closed the browser they are cancelled, they are CDs “Temporary cookies”. However, longer term cookies can be used, CDs “Persistent cookies”, which remain on the device for a longer time or till when they are manually cancelled (how long the cookie remains on the device will depend by the ‘life duration’ of the mentioned cookie and by the browser setting) they are aimed to recognize for this period the visitor computer through an alpha-number code generated in the first access section. Their disabling can compromise the use of the services accessible by login. The public part of the Site remains normally usable.
- **Technical analysis and performances cookies.** They are cookies used to collect and analyse the traffic and the use of the site anonymously and in an aggregated form. These cookies, though without identifying the user, for example, allow to detect if the same user returns to connect at different times. They also allow to monitor the system and to improve the performances and the usability. Disabling these cookies can be done without any loss of functionality.
- **Profiling Cookie.** These are the permanent cookies used to identify (anonymously and not) the user preferences and to improve their browsing experience.
- **First part cookies,** that is cookies generated and managed directly by the subject operator of the website on which the user is browsing.

- **Third-part cookies**, which are generated and managed by subjects other than the operator of the website on which the user is browsing. By visiting a website you can receive cookies both of the visited site (“owners”), or from sites managed by other organizations (“third parties”). A notable example is represented by the presence of the “social plugin” for Facebook, Twitter, Google+ and LinkedIn. These are parts of the visited page generated directly from these sites and integrated into the page of the host site. The most common use of the plugin is finalized to share the contents on the social network. The presence of these plugin involves the transmission of cookies from and to all the sites managed by “third parties” is governed by the relevant informative to be referred to. To grant greater transparency and convenience, we report here below the web addresses of the different informative and how to manage the cookies.

### **Google Analytics and other profiling cookies**

The “www.talos-sec.com” site includes also some components transmitted by Google Analytics, a web traffic analysis service provided by Google, Inc. (“Google”). This is also the case with third-party cookies collected and managed anonymously to monitor and improve the performance of the host site (performance cookie).

Google Analytics uses "cookies" to collect and anonymously analyse information about website usage behaviours (including the user’s IP address). These information are collected by Google Analytics, which processes it for the purpose of compiling reports for site operators regarding the activities on the website itself. This site does not use (and does not allow third parties to use) the Google analytic tools to monitor or to collect personal identifiable information. Google does not associate the IP address with any other data owned by Google nor does it attempt to link an IP address with a user identity. Google can also communicate these information to third parties where this is imposed by the law or where such third parties treat the aforementioned information on behalf of Google.

### **Characteristics of the provided Service**

The Website hosting is managed by Register (register.it).

The application Approver uses DigitalOcean (digitalocean.com) for the services hosting; Compose (compose.com) to manage the database; Github (github.com) for the hosting of the service source code; DockerHub (docker.com) for the hosting of the service source code; Mailgun (mailgun.com) to send automatic emails; Jotty (virusscan.jotti.org) for the antivirus service.

The payments are managed by Stripe (stripe.com) for the automatic payments and Octobat (octobat.com) for the automatic invoicing and the customer management

### **How to control or cancel the cookies**

Most of internet browsers are initially set to accept the cookies automatically. You can change these settings to block the cookies or to warn that the cookies are sent to your device. There are several ways to manage the cookies: you can refer to the manual instructions or to the browser help screen to find out how to adjust or modify the settings. Disabling the cookies the navigation may be affected, for example certain sections may be inhibited or you may not receive personalized information when you visit a site.

If you use different devices to view and access to Internet sites (for example, computer, smartphone, tablet, exc.), you should be sure that each browser on each device is regulated to reflect the preferences relevant to the cookies.

### **Technical and statistical cookies used by the site [www.talos-sec.com](http://www.talos-sec.com)**

The technical Cookies have the function of allowing the performance of activities strictly related to the operations of this online space. The technical Cookies used by this site can be divided into the following subcategories:

- **Navigation Cookie**, by which you can save the browsing preferences and optimize the User's browsing experience;
- **Cookie analytics**, by which the statistical information is acquired about the navigation way of the Users. Such information are treated in an aggregated and anonymous form;
- **Cookie of functionality**, including third parties, used to activate specific features of this online space and necessary to deliver the service or to improve it.

The following Technical Cookie do not need the preventive consent of the User to be installed and used.

In case you use some of these contents, Google Analytics stores the additional data on your computer, known also as Flash cookie (or Local Share Object) through which the holder is able to know the total number of times in which it is opened a certain audio/video file, the number of persons who use it to the end and how many people, instead close it before the end. We remind that limiting and/or eliminating the use of this type of flash cookies can affect the available functions for the applications based on the Flash technology.
