

# EXHIBITS, RESTAURANTS AND FASTFOOD

The zoo is divided into biogeographical areas corresponding to the coloured arrows in the map: Europe, Australia, Asia, Africa, South America, North America.

**A Siberian forest**  
birds flying freely around you – Red Crossbill, owl, waxwing, hawfinch, bunting

**B Settlement from the Iron Age**  
a replica of an elevated settlement, supplemented by thematic events of the Revived (pre)history association and utility plants in the summer season

**C Czech river**  
otters, all four fish zones from the spring to the mouth according to the river Uhlava including its characteristic flora

**D Lüftnerka farm**  
domestic animals, blacksmith's shop, joiner's shop, agricultural machinery, housing exposition, petting zoo, old varieties and a ZOO-SCHOOL, children's playground in a loft

**E African-asian pavilion**  
giraffes, blassbocks, nyalas, kudus, zebras, hyraxes, reptiles, rhinoceroses, the Naked Mole-rats, Treasures of Islands

**F A Tree as an Eco-system**  
An Oak Tree House, full of interesting things

**G Macaronesia**  
fauna and flora of the Canary Islands, Madeira and the Azores

**H Madagascar**  
day and night world of Madagascar, lemurs, tortoises, geckos, Ring-tailed Mongoose, fruitbats, Malagasy Giant Rats, boas, fish

**I The underground world**  
life in caves, tombs, sewers, wells, cellars and punkva caves; a mini-museum of war and formation of the botanical garden; an exhibit Zikmund & Hanzelka

**J Tropical pavilion**  
The Philippines Exhibit – Butterflies' Paradise, the Kingdom of Venom, Talarak, lemurs, chimpanzees, Giant Tortoises

**R Mlsání u veverky**

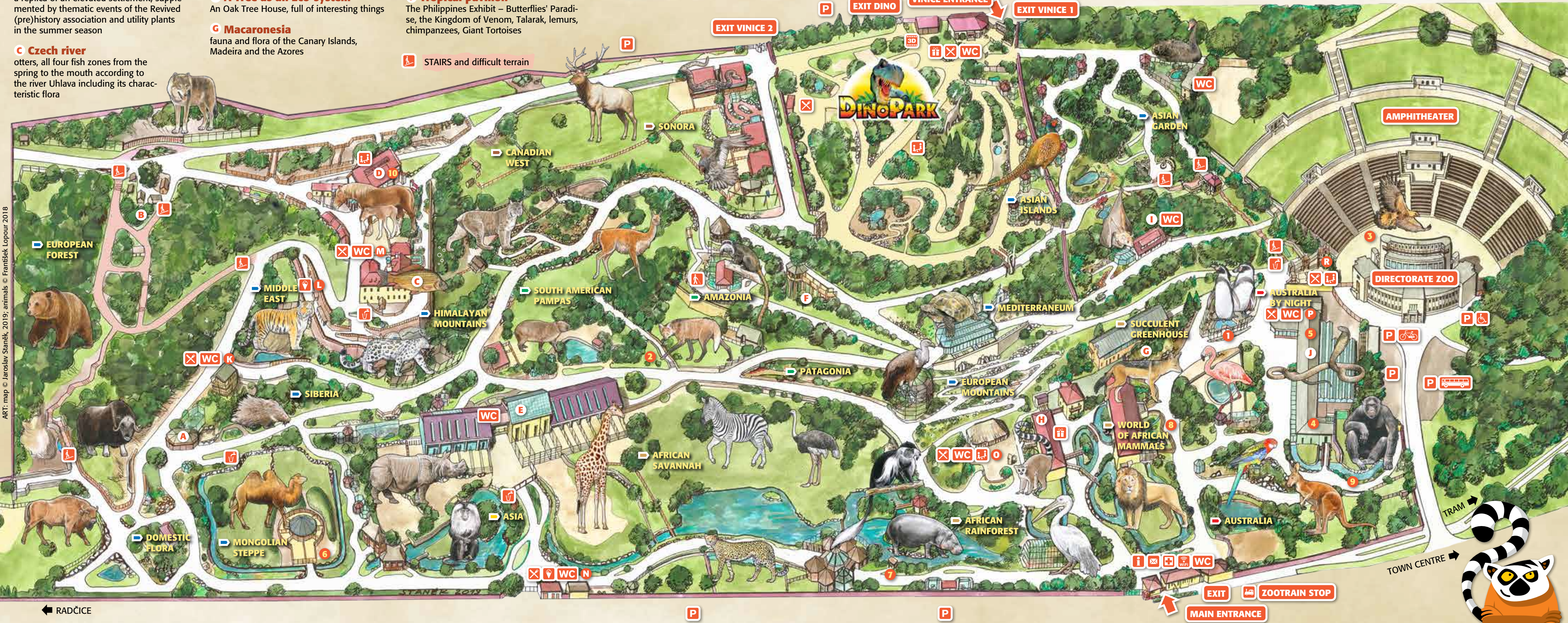
