10. Rome

Rome is as impressive on your first visit as it is on your 30th: that first glimpse of the Colosseum, those plates overflowing with cacio e pepe, that ancient allure that somehow never fades. This spring, try to emerge from your monument-checklist mode and check out some of the city's hottest hotel openings—including Grand House, a new type of villa rental just launched by the Micangeli brothers. Then spend a few peaceful hours at Villa Doria Pamphilj, Rome's largest public park featuring manicured gardens, stretches of forrest, pine groves, and bits of wild vegetation.

Stay here: **Hotel Vilòn**, a mansion-turned-boutique-hotel with light-filled rooms and a lovely private courtyard.
