## Bulky waste (low and high-rise homes)

Bulky waste, such as furniture and large household appliances, does not belong in the collection container for residual waste or in your grey residual waste container. Here is what you can do with it:



### Secondhandshop (thrift store)

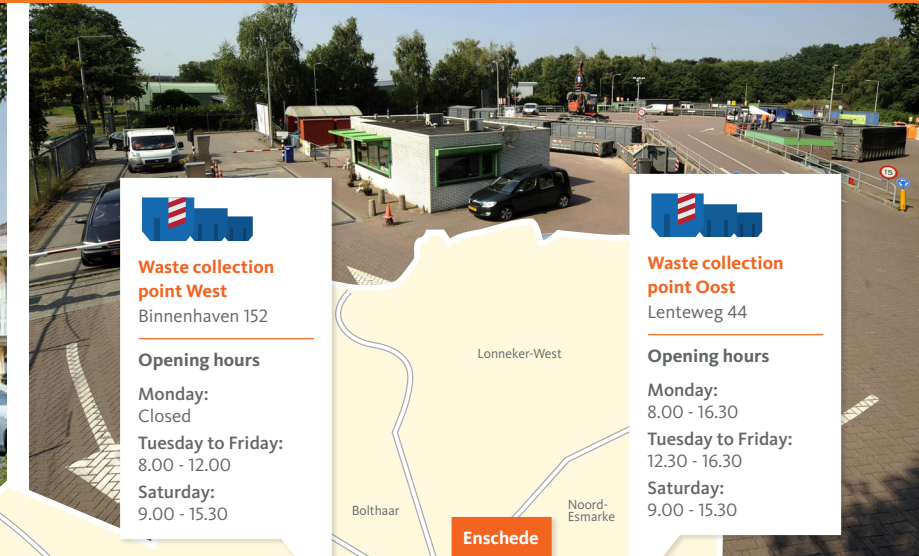
### Bring the items yourself

You can take bulky waste to one of the three waste collection points in Enschede (see the map on the next page). You can dispose of 75 kilos free of charge in 2026. Some waste types are always free of charge.



### Have the items collected

At the waste collection point you can dispose of many types of waste, such as bulky garden waste, mattresses, electrical appliances and household hazardous waste. You will need your environmental pass for this.

# Enschede without waste

In Enschede, you pay a fixed annual fee plus additional charges for residual waste. Other waste types can be disposed of free of charge, such as paper and packaging. By separating your waste properly, you pay less. It also means less waste is incinerated. That is better for the environment.

## Why separate waste?

By separating your waste, you help the environment and save money. Residual waste is incinerated and cannot be reused. If you separate properly, only a small amount of residual waste remains. You pay each time you dispose of residual waste. The better you separate, the less you pay.

Residual waste is everything that remains after reusable waste (for example paper, packaging and organic waste) has been separated. These reusable materials are used to make new products.

## Your environmental pass

Each household has 1 environmental pass. Please leave the environmental pass in the home when you move.



### Opening collection containers

With the environmental pass, you can open the collection container for residual waste. Do you live in a high-rise building (flat/apartment)? Then you can also use the environmental pass to open the collection container for organic waste.



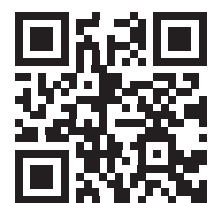
### Access to the waste collection point

With the environmental pass, you have access to the waste collection point. At the waste collection point you can dispose of bulky waste, such as bulky garden waste, wood, mattresses, electrical appliances and household hazardous waste.

### Don't have an environmental pass?

Request one free of charge within 3 months after moving via [www.twentemilieu.nl/milieupas](http://www.twentemilieu.nl/milieupas) or call Twente Milieu customer service on 0900 85 20 111 (weekdays between 08:00 and 17:00, local rate). After 3 months, or if you lose your pass, you will pay €10 for a new pass.

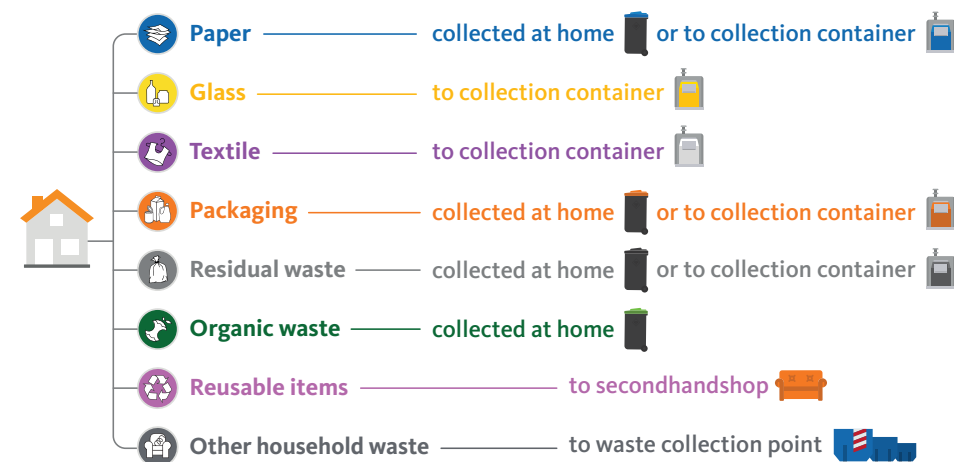

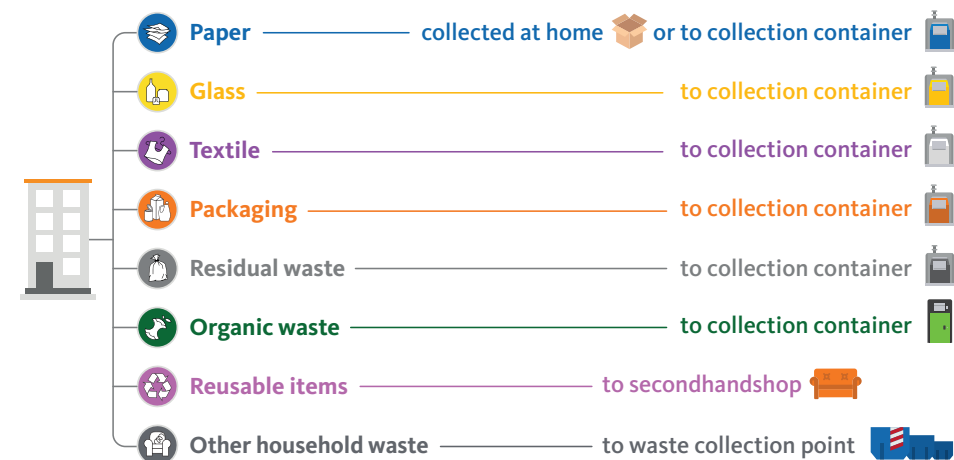
## Where can you deposit your waste?

The method of collection differs depending on whether you live in a low-rise or high-rise home (apartment/flat). Below you can see where you can deposit your waste.

### Low-rise home



### High-rise home



### Containers at home (low-rise homes only)

This is how waste is collected from your home:



**RESIDUAL WASTE** Once every 4 weeks  
Pay per disposal



**PAPER** Once every 4 weeks\*  
Free



**ORGANIC WASTE** Once every 2 weeks  
Free



**PACKAGING** Once every 4 weeks  
Free

\* Outside the built-up area, paper is collected at home every 8 weeks

### Which waste bags are suitable for residual waste?

You can use waste bags of up to 40 litres (such as pedal-bin liners) for the container for residual waste. You can buy these at the supermarket.

Larger bags do not fit and will block the container for the next user.

### Collection containers for residual waste (low-rise and high-rise homes)

All households in Enschede can use the collection containers for residual waste. You can open the containers with your environmental pass.

### Collection container for organic waste (high-rise homes)

Residents of high-rise homes (apartment/flat) can dispose of their food scraps in the collection container for organic waste. You can use the collection container for organic waste near your apartment building. You can open the collection container for organic waste with your environmental pass.



### Environmental squares (low-rise and high-rise homes)

Environmental squares are small clusters of collection containers. You often find these near shopping centres. Here you can dispose of your separated waste free of charge.



Only small quantities fit in the **paper container**. Therefore, tear cardboard boxes into smaller pieces first.

Use closed bags for **textiles**, so the textiles stay dry.

You can put loose **glass** items into the glass container, including lids and any remaining scraps or residue.

Use transparent bags of up to 60 litres for **packaging**.
