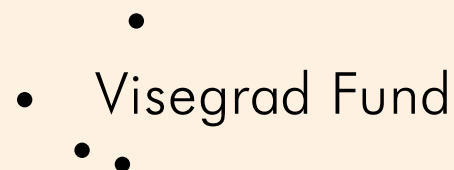
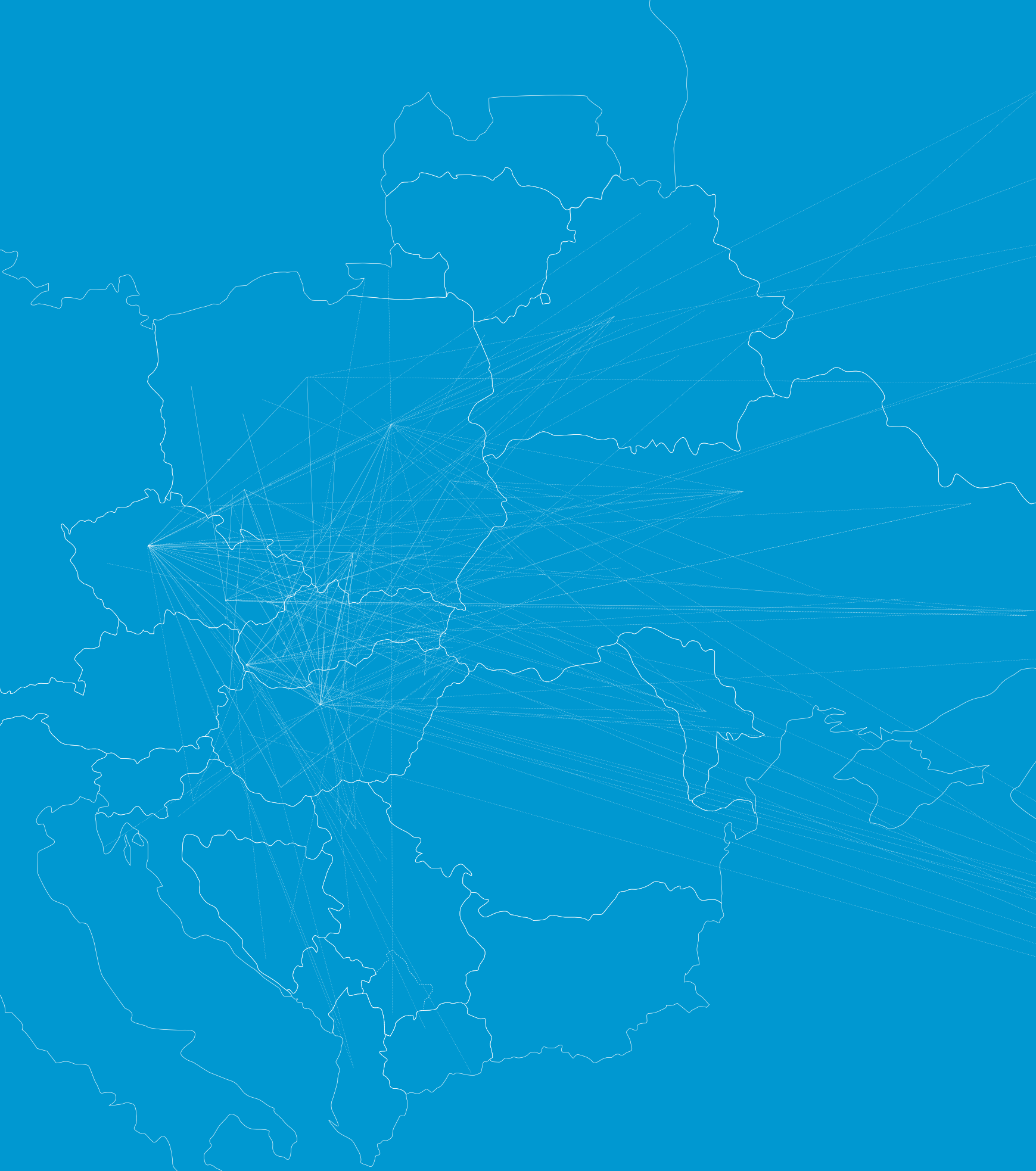

# foreword

Dear friends,

In 2010 we commemorated the 10th anniversary of the Fund’s establishment. The first decade of human life is a period in which we collect our experience and take our first unsupported steps. The life of an institution is, however, driven by different rules—we can say that, first of all, the pace of institutions is faster. If we were now to say that the Fund has taken its first steps, it would not be a great achievement. I am glad to be able to say that much more has been done. I wrote here a year ago that we would like to make the Fund friendlier. The first steps toward changes in the grant management had then already been taken, but we still needed some time to attain our final goal. We wanted to make use of the joint experience we at the Fund have acquired together with you, the applicants. The most substantial aim of the intended changes was to create a system that preserves positive experiences, while improving the deficiencies and problems that our grantees have faced.

The new system was launched on March 1, 2011. I believe that the new grant management incorporated in the system better addresses the needs of the grantee. The most important change we have made is in the area of financing: as most of our experience in grant implementation was positive, we have found it possible to replace the previous system of reimbursement with *disbursement*. We believe that this step makes the lives of our grantees easier and gives smaller applicants, in particular, better access to our grants. The same motivation is behind the other changes—for instance, *raising our co-financing to 70%* and establishing a 5% *overhead-cost* possibility.

I hope that these changes increase competition and consequently further raise the quality of supported grants. A clear V4 feature—or something like “*Visegrad added value*”—will be the most crucial criterion during the selection process. This refers to the involvement of all Visegrad partners, where possible, and the development of real joint projects. The Fund was established to foster and intensify the movement of people and ideas in the Visegrad region. Projects supported by the Fund must, as a result, fulfill this primary purpose.

I would like to wish you a great deal of creativity in our shared endeavor to strengthen cooperation in the region and stimulate the further awareness of our mutual fellowship.

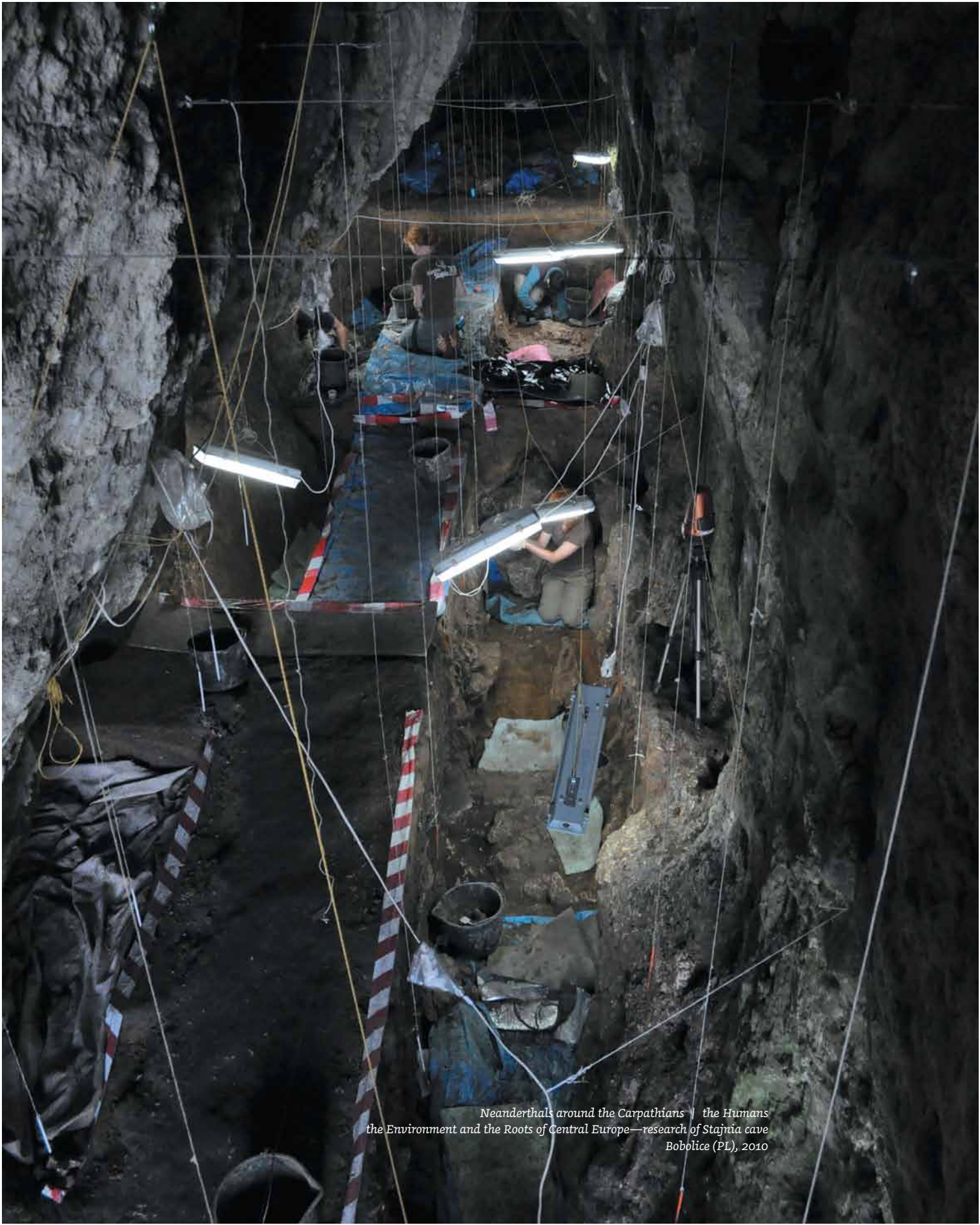

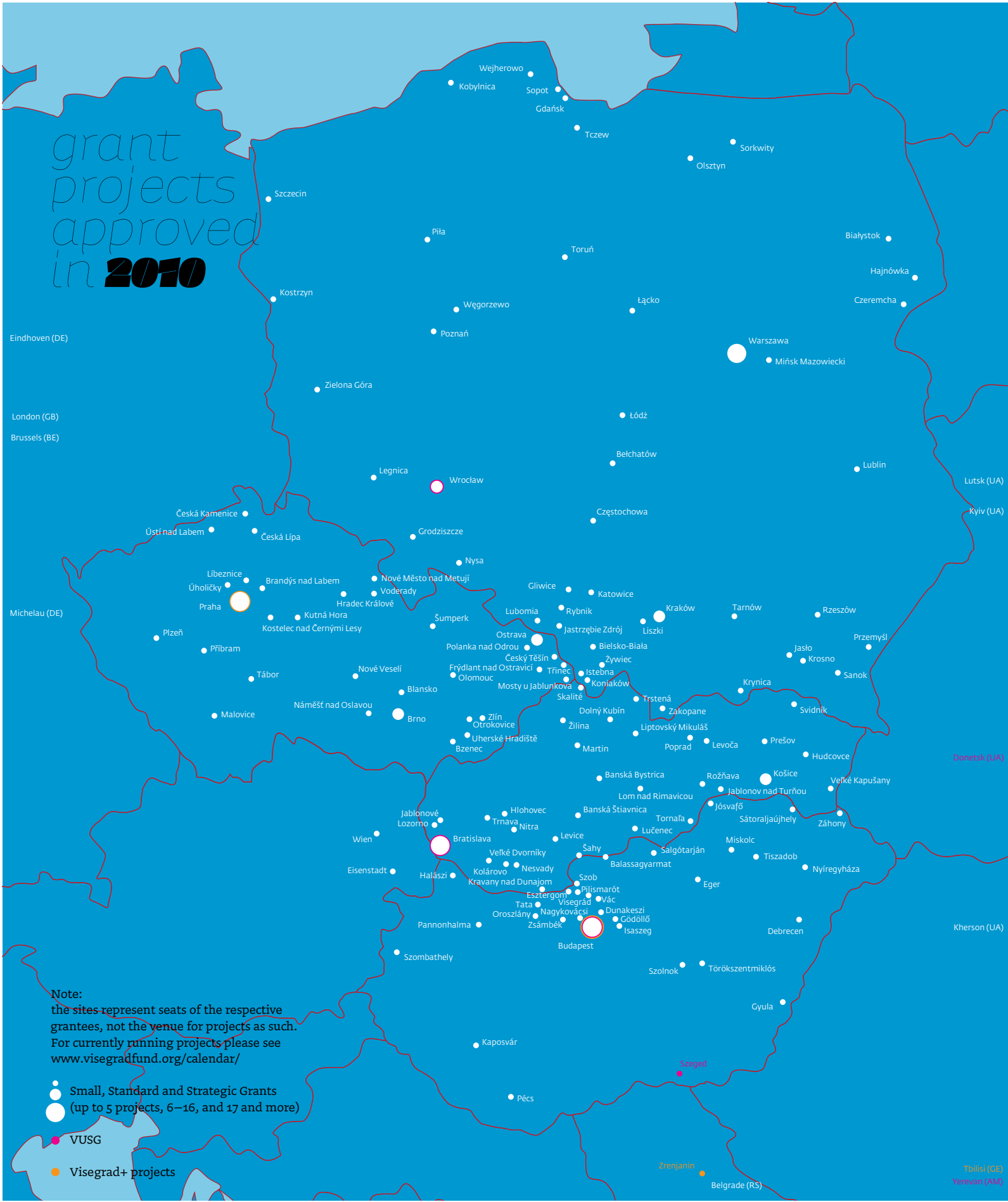

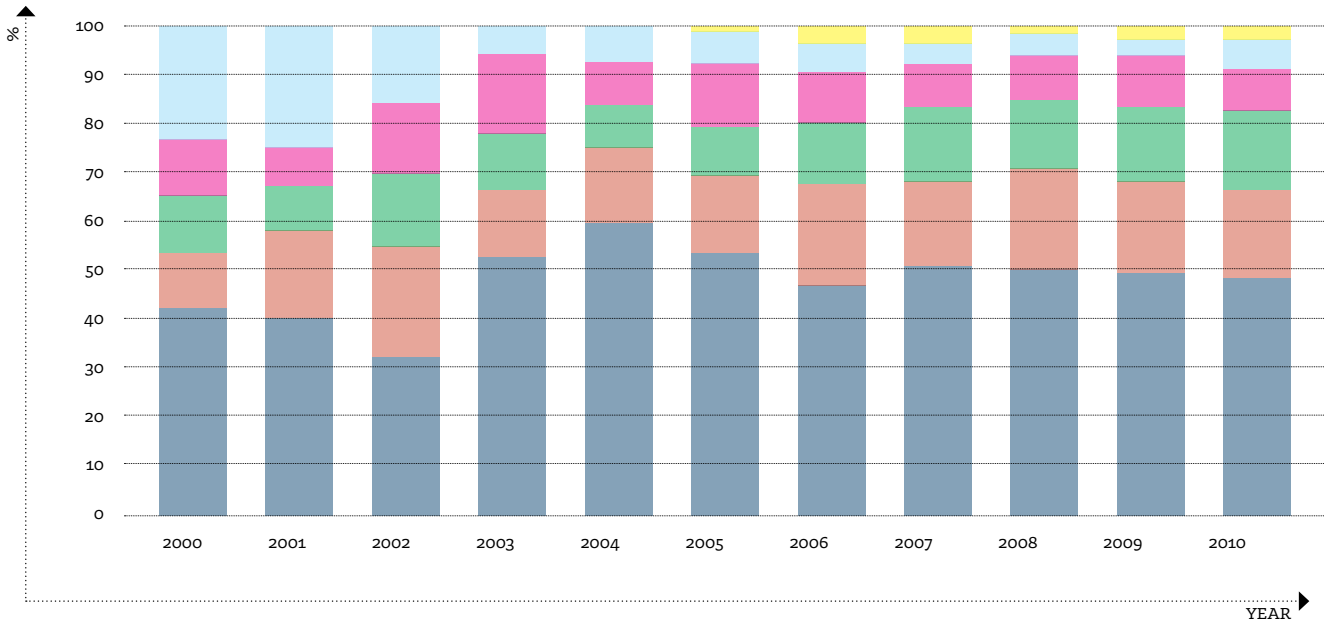

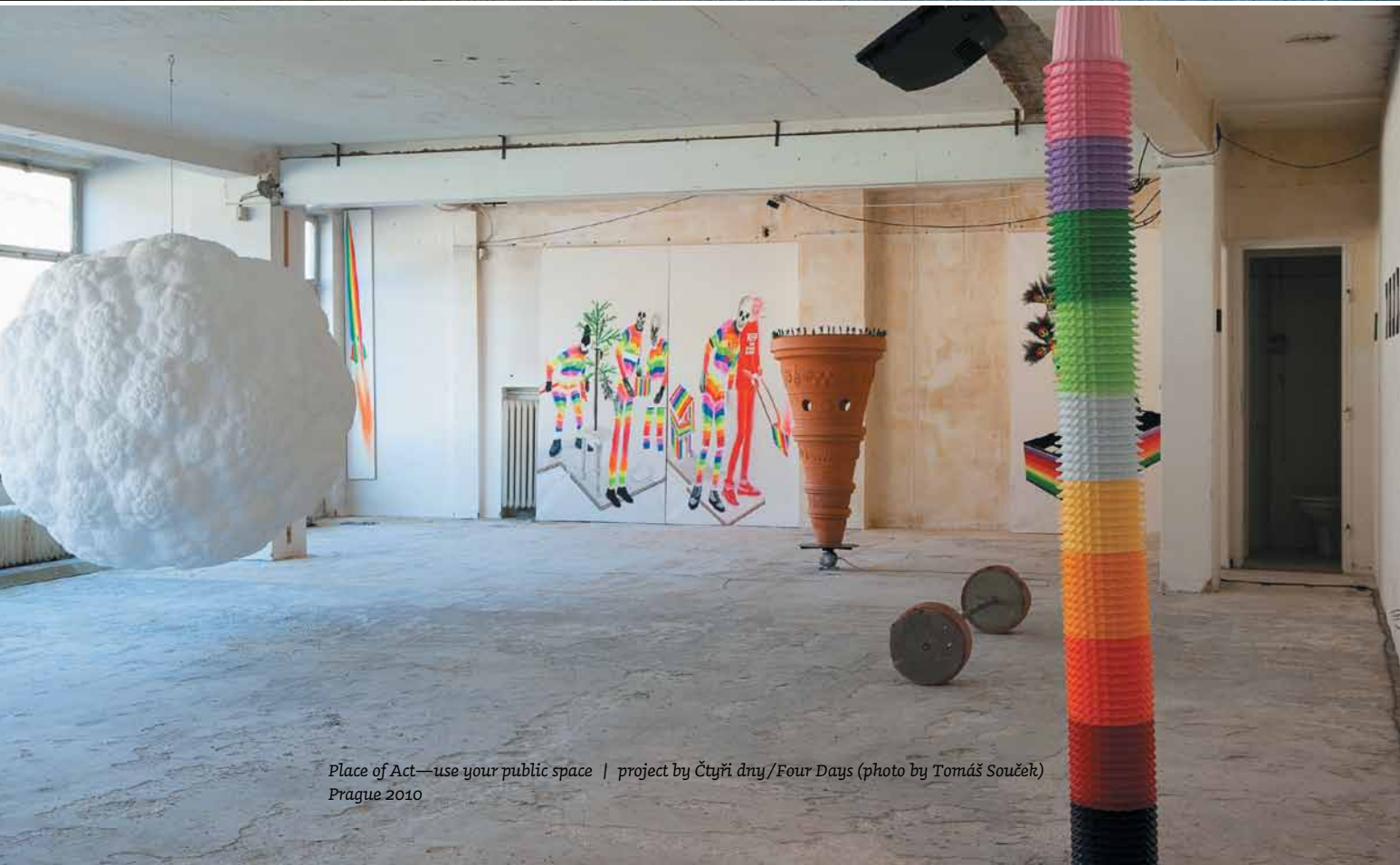

# grant programs

## small grants

The Small Grants program was launched in 2002. It is suitable for projects smaller in scope and implementation period—projects can request up to **€5,000** for a maximum period of **6 months**. About 150 Small Grant projects are approved annually in the following categories: cultural cooperation, science and research, education, youth exchanges, cross-border cooperation and promotion of tourism. The Fund can cover **up to 70% of project costs**.

## standard grants

The Standard Grants program is the Fund's oldest grant program. Standard Grants are suitable for most project proposals. The implementation period for projects can be up to **12 months** and requested budget must be **€5,001 or more** (on average it is about €10,000 per project). About 250 Standard Grant projects are funded annually in the same categories as within Small Grants—cultural cooperation, science and research, education, youth exchanges, cross-border cooperation and promotion of tourism. The Fund can cover **up to 70% of project costs**.

## visegrad strategic program **strategic grants**

The Visegrad Strategic Program was established in 2005 with the aim to foster cooperation in areas which correspond with the priorities of the Visegrad Group. These priorities are defined annually by the Group's rotating presidency. Projects requesting support within Strategic Grants must adhere to these priorities and must be of strategic character (only experienced applicants are encouraged to apply). More than 30 such projects have been approved so far with the average supported sum of €40,000 per project. Implementation period for Strategic Grant projects is between **12 and 36 months** and the Fund can cover **up to 70% of total project costs**.

2. Promotion of the Group in Central Europe and the EU as part of the 20th anniversary of its establishment
3. Social inclusion of the Roma population
4. Youth and sports exchanges

## visegrad university studies grant **vusg**

The program started in 2008 with the aim to financially support the development and launching of university courses and degree programs that deal with specific phenomena related to the Visegrad Group countries. Any accredited college or university worldwide can apply.

## visegrad+

Program established in 2008 to administer and finance projects contributing to democratization and transformation processes in selected countries and regions (particularly in non-EU member states in Eastern Europe, the Western Balkans and the South Caucasus). There are no regular deadlines and projects are solicited through separate **calls for proposals**. So far three calls took place towards **Belarus** (2008 and 2009), **Serbia** (2009) and **Georgia** (2010).

# individual programs

## visegrad scholarship program **vsq**

The Visegrad Scholarship Program was initiated in 2003 and to date enabled more than 1,000 studies abroad in the broader region of Central and Eastern Europe, the Western Balkans and the South Caucasus. The “Visegrad scholarships” are unique in the freedom they offer to each scholar—as there is no list of applicable schools, scholars can choose to study at **any accredited college or university** (or science academy) in selected country. Funding is extended to both the scholar and the respective host university. As of 2010, scholars residing more than 1,500 km away from the host university are eligible for a one-time **travel grant**.

## visegrad scholarships at open society archives **osa**

Initiated in 2010 in cooperation with the Open Society Archives (OSA) at the Central European University in Budapest, the program offers research fellowships to scholars, researchers but also journalists and documentary filmmakers at OSA. 8 fellowships are available for fellows from the Visegrad Group countries (2 for each) and 2 fellowships are available for non-V4 applicants.

## visegrad artist residency program **varp**

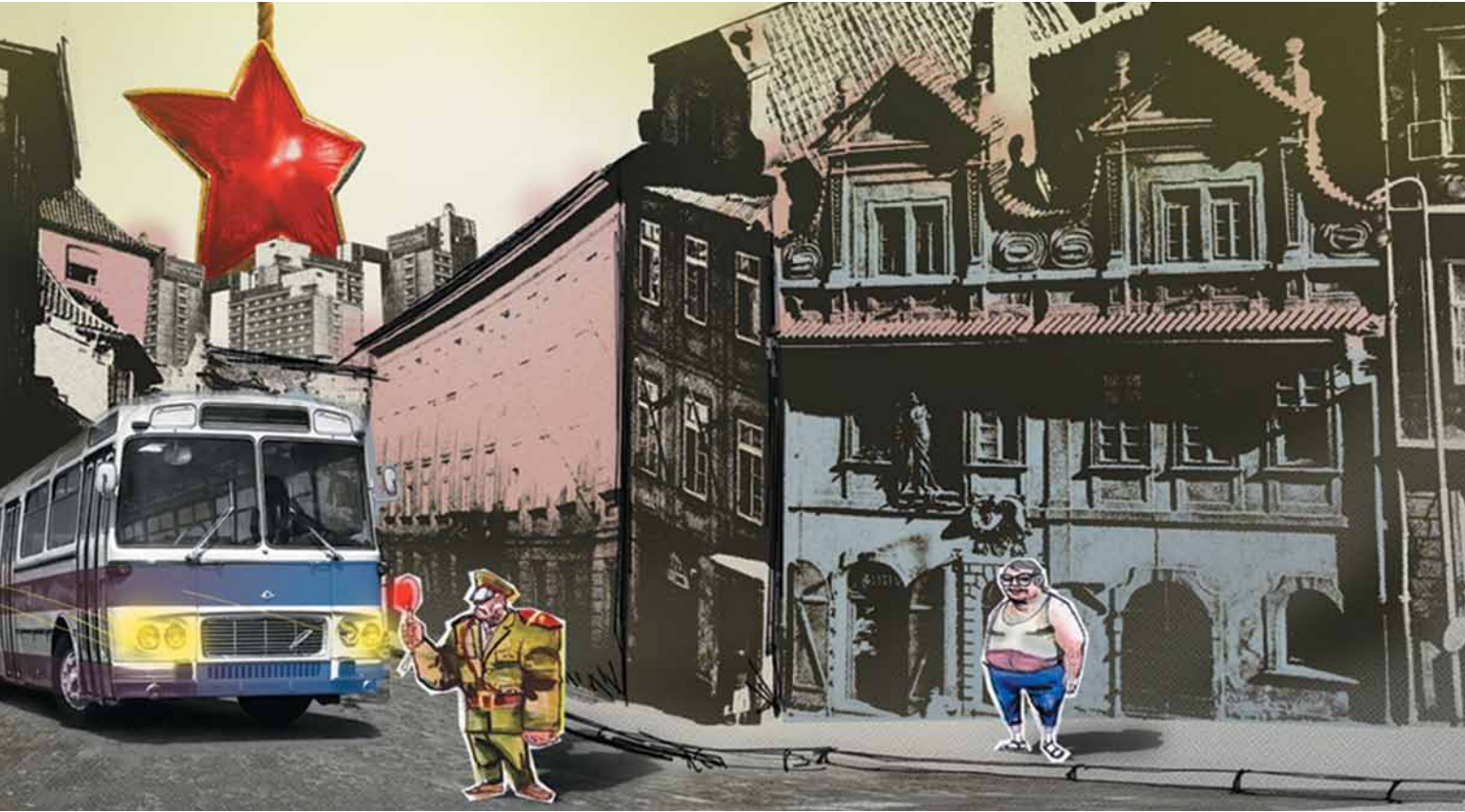
The Visegrad Artist Residency Program is one of the Fund’s youngest programs. Established only in 2007, the mission behind VARP has been to foster exchange of ideas and experiences in all forms of the arts in the region, through simple funding in the form of artists in residence. In the five rounds of deadlines so far VARP enabled residencies to more than 100 artists (please see our on-line gallery).

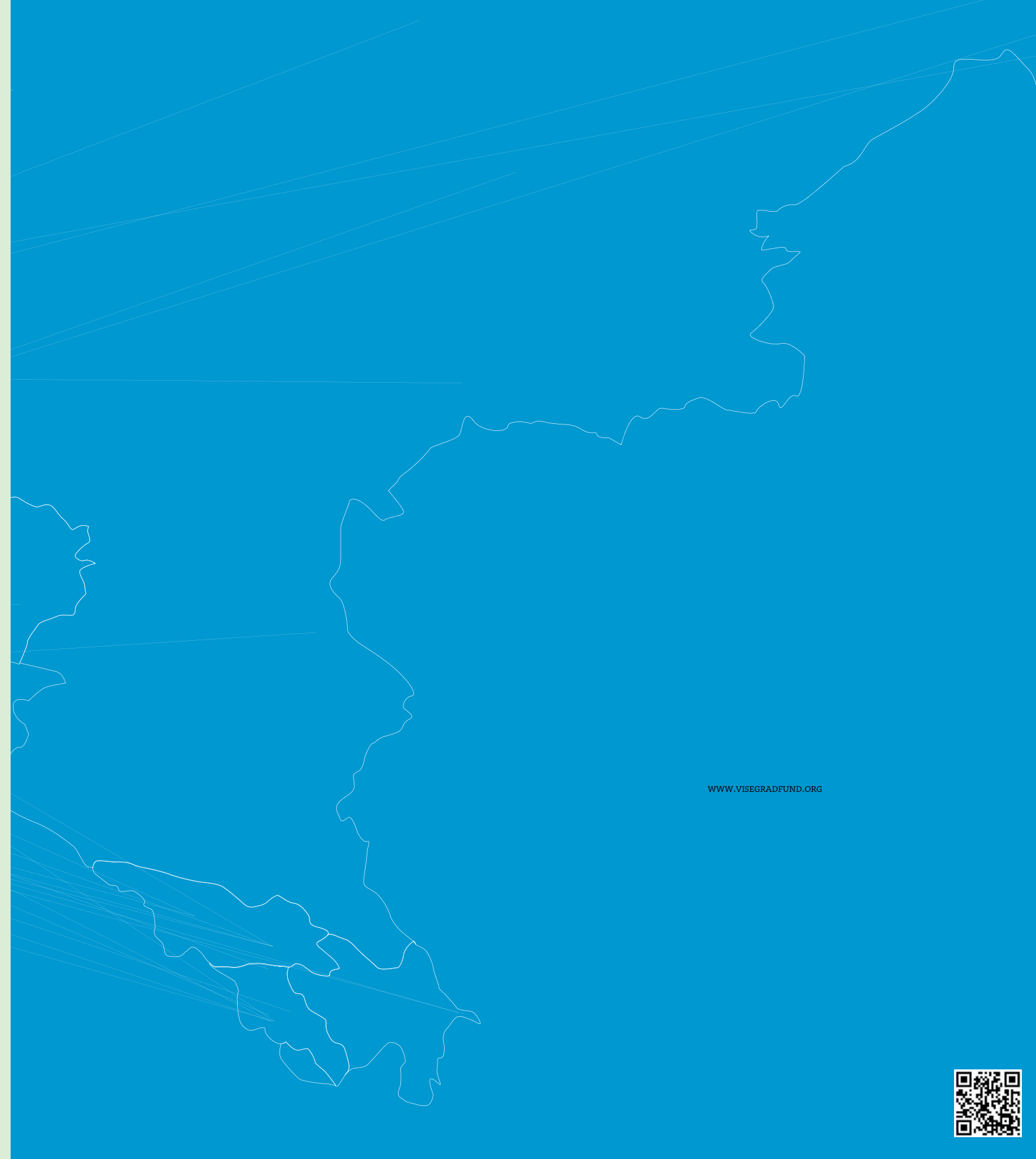
