

Dear friends.

Let me open my overview of the International Visegrad Fund's activities with a brief reminiscence. In 2004, the prime ministers of the Visegrad countries met in Kroměříž to consider the destiny of Visegrad cooperation.

Visegrad countries had by then met the goals that had brought them together thirteen years earlier within the Visegrad Group. This famous return to Europe was completed through successful accession negotiations with the European Union, and raised the question of further cooperation in the group. The 2004 summit resolved this question in a positive way.

It was decided that Visegrad cooperation would not just continue; its agenda was enriched by a new issue. "The Visegrad Group countries are ready to use their unique regional and historical experience to contribute to shaping and implementing the European Union's policies towards the countries of Eastern and Southeastern Europe."

The International Visegrad Fund has become an important tool in supporting this plan. Step by step, new mobility and grant programs focusing on Eastern and Southeastern Europe have been established. In 2011, the Visegrad 4 Eastern Partnership program was approved at a prime ministers' summit in Bratislava. V4EaP is now the biggest program that the Fund has ever run outside the Visegrad region.

At times we may hear the reproach that the Fund should focus its activities within the Visegrad region rather than outside it. No doubt the main mission of the Fund remains the strengthening of the internal cohesion of the region but, on the other hand, there are good reasons why the Fund should pay more attention to non-Visegrad countries.

One of these reasons lies at the historical and ethical levels. When the V4 countries stood at the threshold of the transformation process, they could rely on help from Western countries willing to share their know-how, just as they provided material help. I think it is time for us to try to pay this historical debt forward and help our neighbors.

At the same time, this is our visible contribution to the EU's endeavor to broaden the belt of stability and prosperity in Europe. This is also a significant contribution to ourselves—to the V4 region—because it is unwise to enjoy one's own welfare without addressing the problems that one's neighbors may be facing.

The new program also represents an interesting opportunity for V4 NGOs to develop and intensify their activities in the countries involved in the Eastern Partnership. Not only can they strengthen their capacities, but also look for and engage with new local partners. The broader and more intensive this cooperation is, the better.

New opportunities lay ahead. Let's use them well.

The International Visegrad Fund is an international organization established by the governments of the Visegrad Group (V4) countries—the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and Slovakia—in 2000. Seated in Bratislava, the Fund has the status of an international organization accredited by the Slovak foreign ministry. The Fund's main mission is fostering closer contacts and deeper cooperation among people in the region and the development of civil society primarily in Central and Eastern Europe, the Western Balkans and the South Caucasus. The Fund financially supports common grant projects and awards individual mobility projects (scholarships and artist residencies). By the end of 2011 the Fund granted nearly 3,400 projects and over 1,300 individual scholarships and residencies in the total amount of nearly €39 million.

Main recipients of the funding are NGOs and non-profit organizations, municipalities and local governments, schools and universities, research institutions but also individual citizens and private companies.

The Fund's annual budget of €7 million consists of equal contributions from the V4 governments.

grant programs

SMALL GRANTS

The Small Grants program was launched in 2002. It is suitable for projects smaller in scope and implementation period—projects can request up to €6,000 for a maximum period of 6 months. About 150 Small Grant projects are approved annually in the following categories: cultural cooperation, science and research, education, youth exchanges, cross-border cooperation and promotion of tourism. The Fund can cover up to 70% of total project costs with overhead costs not exceeding 5% of the granted sum.

STANDARD GRANTS

The Standard Grants program is the Fund's oldest grant program. Standard Grants are suitable for most project proposals. The implementation period for projects can be up to 12 months and requested budget must be €6,001 or more (on average it is about €10,000 per project). About 250 Standard Grant projects are funded annually in the same categories as within Small Grants—cultural cooperation, science and research, education, youth exchanges, cross-border cooperation and promotion of tourism. The Fund can cover up to 70% of total project costs with overhead costs not exceeding 5% of the granted sum.

VISEGRAD STRATEGIC PROGRAM (STRATEGIC GRANTS)

The Visegrad Strategic Program was established in 2005 with the aim to foster cooperation in areas which correspond with the priorities of the Visegrad Group. These priorities are defined annually by the Group's rotating presidency. Projects requesting support within Strategic Grants must adhere to these priorities and must be of strategic character (only experienced applicants are encouraged to apply). Nearly 50 Strategic Grants have been approved so far with the average supported sum of €40,000 per project. Implementation period for Strategic Grant projects is between 12 and 36 months and the Fund can cover up to 70% of total project costs. Overhead costs within Strategic Grants cannot exceed 5% of total granted amount.

VISEGRAD UNIVERSITY STUDIES GRAN

The program started in 2008 with the aim to financially support the development and launching of university courses and degree programs that deal with specific phenomena related to the Visegrad Group countries. Any accredited college or university worldwide can apply.

The Visegrad Scholarship Program was initiated in 2003 and to date enabled more than 1,100 studies abroad in the broader region of Central and Eastern Europe, the Western Balkans and the South Caucasus. Visegrad scholarships are unique in the freedom they offer to each scholar—given the fact there is no closed list of applicable host universities, scholars can freely choose to study at any accredited college or university (or science academy) in selected country. Funding is extended to both the scholar and the respective host university. Scholars residing more than 1,500 km away from the host university can also apply for a one-time travel grant.

The Visegrad Artist Residency Program is one of the Fund's youngest programs. In the six rounds of deadlines so far the residency program enabled residencies to nearly 150 artists.

visegrad 4 eastern partnership

The International Visegrad Fund launches the Visegrad 4 Eastern Partnership program (V4EaP) as part of long-term strategic focus on the countries of Eastern Europe and the South Caucasus along the EU's Eastern Partnership initiative—Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine.

The program is launched in 2012 with the initial budget of €1,456,800 (a separate chapter increased for the V4EaP program in 2012). The program structure follows the dual structure the Fund's employs within its other programs, i.e., the grant and mobility components. The program is intended to implement the following long-term priorities of the Visegrad Group in the region: sharing of the V4 transformation experience, regional cooperation, cross-border cooperation and support of civil society.

The Rules for the programs were adopted by the decision of the ministers of foreign affairs of the Visegrad Group countries at their meeting in Prague on March 5, 2012. The Fund is negotiating joint funding for this program with other parties.






