Subject and acceptance

This Liability Waiver (the “Waiver”) sets out the conditions under which guests and players (“Participants”) use Pixel Run’s active, movement-based services, and the risk-acceptance and liability rules that apply to them.

Acceptance does not require a separate signature. By entering the Pixel Run premises, passing through the gate associated with a booking, or actually taking part in a Game, the Participant — or in the case of a minor, the **Responsible Adult** (see section 5) — **accepts this Waiver by conduct, expressly**

and unambiguously. Pixel Run makes the Waiver available at entry and on the play-area screens, and publishes it permanently on pixelrun.hu.

Related documents

This Waiver is to be read together with, and supplements:

- **General Terms and Conditions (ÁSZF)** — in particular sections 12 (conduct), 13 (safety) and 14 (liability cap);
- **House Rules (Házirend)** — on-site behaviour and safety;
- **Event Policy (Rendezvény Szabályzat)** — birthday room, group events;
- **Pass Policy (Bérlet Szabályzat)** — multi-entry prepaid passes;
- **Privacy Policy (Adatvédelmi Tájékoztató)** — CCTV, marketing imagery, health data.

All listed documents are available on the Pixel Run website. In case of conflict, the topic-specific policy prevails over this Waiver.

1. Nature and risk of the activity

Pixel Run's services are **active, movement-based activities** that involve significant physical exertion (running, sudden direction changes, jumping, fast reaction) and **inherently carry a risk of injury** (in particular: sprains, strains, bruises, falls, collisions with other Participants or play-area elements). The LED floor also uses **fast, intense visual effects**.

Participants use the service **at their own risk**.

2. Fitness for participation — required representations

The Participant — or, for a minor, the Responsible Adult — represents, with full awareness of criminal and civil-law liability, that the Participant:

- (a) is healthy, **does not have any infectious disease**, and is not in any acute condition that would pose a public-health risk to others;
- (b) is **not under the influence of medication, narcotics, alcohol, or other psychoactive substances** to a degree that would prevent safe participation;
- (c) **does not suffer from any chronic or recurring condition** that would prevent the regular use of the Game, or through which the Participant could cause illness, injury or damage to themselves, other Participants, or the Operator.

2.1. Photosensitivity and epilepsy

The LED floor uses fast, intense lighting. The service is **not recommended** in the presence of:

- **photosensitivity** or **photosensitive epilepsy**;
- severe **cardiovascular** conditions;
- any **physical exertion** prohibited by a doctor.

Where any of the above applies, the Participant — or the Responsible Adult — must refrain from playing or consult their treating physician beforehand.

2.2. Other circumstances

Please notify staff before entry if the Participant:

- (a) is **pregnant** or recovering from a recent injury or surgery;
- (b) has a chronic **musculoskeletal** condition (spine, knee, ankle, etc.);
- (c) takes **medication** that may affect reaction time or balance;
- (d) has **any other** condition that gameplay could aggravate.

Pixel Run **does not perform** any medical fitness screening and is not required to verify the truthfulness of these representations; assessment of fitness is the responsibility of the Participant or the Responsible Adult.

3. Conduct obligations

The Participant undertakes to:

- (a) read and follow the Pixel Run **House Rules** and the **ÁSZF**;
 - (b) follow staff's verbal and written **instructions** at all times;
 - (c) use the Game and the venue's equipment **as intended**;
 - (d) respect the physical integrity and dignity of other Participants — refrain from aggressive, threatening, demeaning, or deliberately collision-seeking behaviour;
 - (e) refrain from smoking (including e-cigarettes) and from alcohol consumption on the Premises (ÁSZF 12.3 / House Rules section 3).

4. Exclusion from the service

The Participant acknowledges and accepts that a **breach of section 2 or section 3 entitles the Operator — without any obligation to refund or otherwise compensate — to require the Participant to leave the room, the building, or the entire Pixel Run premises immediately**, and that the Participant must comply with that instruction (ÁSZF 12.2).

5. Minors and the Responsible Adult

5.1. **Responsible Adult:** the legal guardian (parent, custodian) of the minor Participant, or an adult authorised in writing by the legal guardian, who accompanies the minor to the Premises or makes the booking on the minor's behalf.

5.2. With respect to the minor's participation, the Responsible Adult represents that they:

- (a) are **entitled** to accept this Waiver on the minor's behalf by conduct;
- (b) have **briefed** the minor on the obligations in sections 2 and 3 and ensure compliance during the Game;
- (c) assume **full responsibility** for the minor's conduct and for any damage caused by the minor (ÁSZF 13.3).

5.3. The Operator is not required to verify the Responsible Adult's authority and bears no responsibility for the truthfulness of the Responsible Adult's representations or for their conduct.

6. Indemnification and liability for damage

6.1. The Participant or the Responsible Adult bears, under the general rules of Hungarian civil law (Act V of 2013 — Civil Code), **full liability for damage** that they:

- (a) cause to Pixel Run, its staff, or other Participants;
- (b) cause — to themselves or to a third party — through breach of sections 2, 3, or 5, or through false representations made under this Waiver.

6.2. **Pixel Run bears no liability for damage falling under section 6.1.** Where damage results from the Participant's or the Responsible Adult's culpable conduct, the Participant — and, where applicable, the Responsible Adult — must bear and indemnify the full damage, including in place of the Operator under the Civil Code.

6.3. The Responsible Adult assumes the obligation to indemnify in full any damage caused by the minor Participant or by other persons under their supervision.

6.4. **The Operator's liability cap** otherwise applies as set out in **section 14 of the ÁSZF**. Nothing in this Waiver excludes or limits liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law — in particular liability for personal injury, death, fraud, or wilful misconduct.

7. In case of injury

7.1. In the event of any injury or medical emergency, the Participant (or another Participant present) must **notify Pixel Run staff without delay**.

7.2. The Operator provides **basic first aid** on site and, where necessary, calls an ambulance. Any further medical care is at the Participant's cost (within the framework of the Hungarian social-security system).

7.3. The Operator records the circumstances of the injury in an internal **incident log**; the processing of the related personal data is governed by the Privacy Policy.

8. Image and audio recordings

8.1. CCTV is operated on the Premises for the security of property and persons and to document gameplay; recording is governed by section 2.11 of the Privacy Policy.

8.2. The Operator may also take or commission marketing photos and video; recording and use are governed by House Rules section 8 and Privacy Policy section 2.12. The Participant has the right to object and — where their face is identifiable — to refuse consent.

9. Final provisions

9.1. This Waiver is governed by **Hungarian law**.

9.2. The Operator may amend this Waiver unilaterally; the current version is always available on the Pixel Run website. Amendments take effect on the date of publication or on the later date stated in the publication, and apply only to entries after that date.

9.3. If any provision of this Waiver is held invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions is not affected.
